Jessica Wethington McLean serves as Planning and Economic Development Director for 14th District Los Angeles City Councilmember Jose Huizar.

The 14th Council District covers the culturally diverse, richly historic and tremendously revitalizing communities of Downtown, Boyle Heights, Hermon, Garvanza, El Sereno, and areas of Northeast Los Angeles, including Eagle Rock, and parts of Highland Park, Glassell Park and Mt. Washington.

In her capacity with Councilmember Huizar, Jessica leads the Council District 14 Planning Group, a dedicated staff which covers policies and projects related to city and community planning; entitlements; major planning initiatives; capital, parks and infrastructure projects; housing; historic preservation; transportation; public works; environment and environmental justice; in addition to the Planning and Land Use Management Committee, of which Councilmember Huizar is Vice-chair.

Jessica has the honor of serving as lead staff for the Councilmember's Bringing Back Broadway initiative, a public-private partnership which will revitalize the city's historic Broadway corridor, and revive the downtown streetcar transportation system to link historic Broadway to all the great new developments throughout downtown.

In her spare time, Jessica is active with political causes, civic and philanthropic organizations, film, and arts and beautification efforts. Jessica lives in the Eagle Rock neighborhood of Los Angeles with her husband Tom McLean, an entertainment journalist, their two dogs and one turtle.
