

WORLD TRADE WEEK 2021 COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

The World Trade Week 2021 Education Committee is sponsoring several \$1000 scholarships for students intending to pursue a career in international trade. Career options in this sector are wide-ranging – a list of potential career pathways is attached. Past sponsors of World Trade Week scholarships include Bank of America, DHL, Yusen Terminals, Deloitte, Comcast NBCUniversal, Los Angeles World Airports and the Ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles. Those who apply for this scholarship will also be in the running to potentially receive another additional \$500 through selection as the Global Trade Scholar Award (more details at the end of this application). The qualifications include:

- 1. <u>Full-time Student</u>: A candidate must be enrolled in a full-time academic program <u>in California</u> relating to international trade with verification of a min. 3.0 GPA. If a student's major does not have an international dimension, an international trade internship will suffice.
- 2. Trade Experience Report (one to two pages): Essay should detail the candidate's demonstrated commitment to a career related to international trade and/or global business through an internship, work experience or key project related to these fields. The internship report should include the name of the organization/company, explain the international aspect of their business, along with a description of activities as an intern or employee. Project-related reports should include a description of key elements learned during the report and concrete plans to pursue a career in the field.

OR

Create a video no more than two minutes that shows viewers what inspired you to take on an international trade related internship and what you plan to do in the future with you've learned. (See guidelines attached).

- 3. <u>Letter of Recommendation:</u> Two Letters of Recommendation, one of the letters must from the faculty member.
- 4. **Future Mentor:** A candidate must be willing to become a future international trade mentor to other students once he or she has become an international business professional

The purpose of the scholarships is to foster international trade education and international business development.

The deadline for submission and receipt of the materials described above is **5 p.m., Friday, March 5**, **2021.** Submitted materials will be reviewed and winners notified by mid-April. The scholarship recipients will be awarded at the annual Kickoff-off Breakfast in downtown Los Angeles. Winners must be present to accept the award and provide proof of enrollment in applicable classes at a valid university or college in order to receive the scholarship check.

To apply:

- 1. Complete an internship in an international trade-related field.
- 2. Write a one-two page internship report or 2 min. video (see requirements attached).
- 3. Request letters of recommendation.
- 4. Provide unofficial or official transcripts
- 5. Email your completed internship report, letter of recommendation, and a copy of your resume to the following:



This award is given to a student that has gone above and beyond their regular role as a student and shows high potential for influencing global trade in their future career. The award stands for academic excellence and outstanding leadership.

Winner will receive an additional \$500 scholarship in addition to their World Trade Week 2021 scholarship. The award will be presented during the main ceremony of the World Trade Week Kickoff Breakfast on May 7, 2021.



WORLD TRADE WEEK 2021 HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS AWARD GUIDELINES

PURPOSE

The World Trade Week Education Committee offers annual scholarship awards to encourage outstanding young women and men to continue in post-secondary study in the field of **International Trade and Business**. The amount of the award is \$500. Career options in this sector are wide-ranging – a list of potential career pathways is attached. Past sponsors of World Trade Week scholarships include Bank of America, DHL, Yusen Terminals, Deloitte, Comcast NBCUniversal, Los Angeles World Airports and the Ports of Long Beach and Los Angeles.

Students who receive the award will be those who plan to pursue studies in programs and careers that reflect a broad definition of **International Trade and Business.** These programs may lead to careers in law, accounting, product development, freight forwarding, port administration, port services, import/export finance and banking, international relations, government service, among others.

Those who apply for this scholarship will also be in the running to potentially receive another additional \$500 scholarship - the Global Trade Scholar Award (more details at the end of this application).

CRITERIA

- 1. Scholarships are awarded to: Graduating high school seniors in California entering an accredited college or university with a standard minimum GPA of 3.0. These students will indicate their interest in participating in the global economy through their choice of career goals discussed in their essay (see below). Please note that their college major does not have to be international business or international relations. Rather the area of most importance is their career choice.
- 2. A complete application includes:
 - a. Scholarship Award Application
 - b. One page, typed, single-spaced, essay discussing the student's future college and career goals. The statement must explain how their chosen career relates to international trade and what they understand international trade to be. (typed) OR
 - 2 min video submission (see criteria attached)
 - c. One letter of recommendation (typed)
 - d. Unofficial or Official high school transcript



WTW Scholarship Video Submission Guidelines

High School Scholarship

Prompt:

"How would you show someone that international trade touches your everyday life?" Create a video no more than two minutes in length that inspires viewers and shows them the importance of international trade in your everyday life.

College Scholarship

Prompt:

"What led you to take on an international trade related internship or project and what has it inspired you to do for the future?"

Create a video no more than two minutes that shows viewers what inspired you to take on an international trade related internship or project and what you plan to do in the future with you've learned. Job-related experience in the field is also applicable.

Submission Process:

Post your video on YouTube and provide us with the link with your application packet.

Video Copyright and Video Image release forms must be submitted for consideration.

Selection Process:

Contestants will be judged on the following criteria:

- (1) Creativity and Originality
- (2) Relevance to prompt
- (3) The quality of your video
- (4) Compliance with the Contest Rules

Videos may be rejected due to the following reasons: Poor video quality, excessive background noise, poor lighting, video volume too loud or too soft, offensive language or content, failure of video submissions to play correctly, video length issues (too short/long) or irrelevance to the subject matter.

Contest Rules & Video Requirements:

Format:

Your video must be in one of the following formats .Mov, .AVI, .MPEG, MP4, FLV and .WMV

Duration: Video submissions must be less than 2 minutes in length.

Resolution:

Recommended resolution for your video is at least 1280x720 (720HD; 16x9 Aspect Ratio).


